- 1. This Invitation for Bids (IFB) follows the General Procurement Notice (GPN) for this Project that appeared in *United Nations Development Business online* UNDB online on 28th February 2019 [Ref AfDB266-02/19].
- 2. The Government of Republic of Kenya has received financing from the African Development Bank in various currencies towards the cost of Nairobi Rivers Basin Rehabilitation and Restoration Program: Sewerage Improvement Project Phase 2. It is intended that part of the proceeds of this loan will be applied to eligible payments under the contract for Supply, Installation, Testing, and Commissioning of 2no. 715 Kva Soundproof Diesel Engine Driven Generators Complete with Generator House at Kariobangi Waste Water Treatment Plant.

The *Athi Water Works Development Agency*, executing agency of the project, now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for the Supply, Installation, Testing, and Commissioning of 2no. 715 Kva Soundproof Diesel Engine Driven Generators Complete with Generator House at Kariobangi Waste Water Treatment Plant, (hereinafter called "the Goods").
